**Absentee Ballot Application Instructions**

This application can only be used when applying for an electronically transmitted absentee ballot for the August 19, 2014 Primary Election. By law, applications may be submitted beginning on August 4, 2014.

**Applications submitted prior to August 4, 2014, will be denied.**

Completed applications must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. Alaska Standard Time on August 18, 2014.

Upon receipt of your completed application your ballot packet or e-mail notification of ballot availability will be sent within 24 to 48 hours.

**When completing this application, provide:**

1. **Alaska residence address:** You **MUST** provide a physical residence address in Alaska. Your application will be denied if you do not provide a physical residence address or if you provide a PO Box, HC Number and Box, PSC Box, Rural Route Number, Commercial Address, or Mail Stop Address in Box 3 of the application.

If your residence has been assigned a street name and house number, provide this information. If your residence address has not been assigned a street name and house number, indicate exactly where you live such as, highway name and milepost number, boat harbor with pier and slip number, subdivision name with lot and block or trailer park name and space number. If you live in rural Alaska, you may provide the community name as your residence address.

**Are you temporarily out of state?** If so, and you have intent to return (active military and military spouses are exempt from intent requirements), you may maintain your Alaska residence as it appears on your current record. If you provide a new residence address, it must be within Alaska.

2. **Identifier:** You **MUST** provide at least one of the following: Voter number, date of birth, Social Security Number, Alaska driver's license or Alaska state identification card number.

3. **How do you want your ballot delivered?** Select the method you wish to receive your ballot:

**Secure Online Voting Solution:** When requesting online delivery, be sure to print your e-mail address clearly and provide telephone contact information. When voting through the secure online voting solution, you will need access to a computer, printer and, if returning the voted ballot through the secure online voting solution, have equipment (such as a scanner) to be able to produce a digital file (PDF, TIFF or JPEG) of the completed Voter Certificate and Identification sheet. If you have not received an e-mail notification that your ballot is available after 48 hours or by August 18, 2014, contact our office by telephone or e-mail to determine if there is an issue with your application or transmission information.

**FAX:** When requesting your ballot to be sent by fax within the United States, provide your area code and fax number. When requesting your ballot to be sent by fax outside the United States, provide your international country code and fax number. **Your fax machine needs to be on, ready, and available to receive your ballot packet.** If you have not received your faxed voting packet after 48 hours or by August 18, 2014, please contact our office by telephone or e-mail to determine if there is an issue with your application or transmission information.

4. **Contact telephone number:** Provide contact information to ensure that our office can reach you if there are any issues with your e-mail address or fax number.
5. **Primary election ballot choice information:** Your political affiliation 30 days before Election Day determines your primary ballot choice. You must select a ballot choice that corresponds to your political affiliation. If you are uncertain of your political affiliation, you may check your registration information at our website located at [www.elections.alaska.gov](http://www.elections.alaska.gov). If you do not make a selection, your application may not be processed.
6. **Sign your application:** If you submit your application without a signature or with an electronic signature, your application will be denied.
