WRITE-IN CANDIDATE FILING REQUIREMENTS

If you did not file for office for the Primary Election, file as a nominating petition candidate for the General Election, or if you were unsuccessful in advancing to the General Election from the Primary Election, and you wish to be a candidate in the General Election, you may file as a write-in candidate. There is no write-in vote on a Primary Election ballot.

Candidates filing as a write-in candidate for a General Election must file a Letter of Intent and a Financial Disclosure Statement with any Division of Elections Office no later than five days before the General Election. Votes for a write-in candidate may not be counted unless the candidate has filed a Letter of Intent with the Division of Elections. *AS* 15.25.105

Write-in votes are reported as a group in each race, combining votes for all write-ins. The write-in votes will be counted if the votes cast for all write-in candidates are the highest number of votes received by any candidate in the race or the second highest number of votes cast in the race by less than the percentage necessary for a recount at the state's cost. *AS 15.15.365, AS 15.20.450*

Below is a checklist provided as a convenience to write-in candidates that are filing for office.

Complete a Letter of Intent. The A33 form is provided in this packet or on the Division of Elections website. <i>AS</i> 15.25.105
Contact the Federal Election Commission for federal reporting deadlines. Candidates for U.S. Senator or U.S. Representative must contact the Federal Election Commission for campaign reporting requirements. These candidates are not subject to the Alaska Public Office Commission requirements. AS 15.25.030(b), AS 15.25.030(c), AS 39.50
File completed forms no later than 5:00 p.m. on the filing deadline, THURSDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2020. All Division of Elections Offices will be open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. AS 15.35.040, AS 15.35.055, AS 15.35.070, AS 15.35.110

METHODS FOR FILING YOUR WRITE-IN PAPERWORK

Candidates may submit a Letter of Intent to any Division of Elections Office and must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day prior to the General Election.

- In person A Letter of Intent may be delivered in person to any Division of Elections Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day prior to the General Election.
- By mail A Letter of Intent sent by mail must be received in any Division of Elections Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day prior to the General Election.
- By reliable electronic transmission A Letter of Intent may be electronically transmitted to any Division of Elections Office and must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on the fifth day prior to the General Election.
