Please write out complete names rather than using acronyms or abbreviations. The Official Election Pamphlet staff will provide you a proofed copy of your page for review prior to publication. We attempt to make the biographical section of the candidate page as uniform as possible. Obvious spelling and/or typographical errors are the only changes we make to the proofed copy, if any.
