

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN THE  
REGULATIONS OF THE DIVISION OF ELECTIONS  
OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

The Division of Elections proposes to adopt regulation changes in Title 6 of the Alaska Administrative Code, dealing with elections in a coastal resource service area, including the following:

- (1) 6 AAC 27.036; 6 AAC 27.037; and 6 AAC 27.065 are proposed to be changed to delete the references to the coastal resource service area (CRSA).
- (2) 6 AAC 27.120, which is the conduct of coastal resource service area elections, is proposed to be repealed.  
  
6 AAC 27.130, which is the certification of coastal resource service area election, is proposed to be repealed.

These changes are being proposed due to the repeal of AS 46.40.150 which was the enabling statute to adopt regulations to conduct coastal resource service area elections.
