STATEMENT:

Individual Rights:

Energy:

We need significant energy relief fast. It has the potential to reduce heating costs by 50-75%, depending on input estimates and could be in a very short amount of time. We need to carefully adjust our tax structure on the North Slope to attract additional capital and increase the throughput of the Alaska Pipeline System. Ignoring this would likely lead to a fiscal crisis just a few years down the line.

Balance the Budget:

I will work hard to ensure our budget remains balanced. With about 90% of revenue coming from oil. We must plan ahead. The state is taking on far too great of a financial risk with respect to the price of oil as is and this must be reduced.
