### Be Prepared for Election Day

(October 29, 2010, Juneau, Alaska) - The Division of Elections is ready for Election Day, are you? Being prepared before going to the polls will help make the voting process go smoothly.

The precinct register at each polling place contains the names of those voters registered at least 30-days before the election. When you go to the correct polling place, you simply sign your name on the register and are given a ballot. If your name is not on the register, you will have to fill out extra paperwork and vote a questioned ballot. To find out where to vote, you can call the division's polling place locator at 1-888-383-8683 (in Anchorage, 269-8683).

When going to the polls, bring a piece of identification such as your driver's license, state ID card, voter ID card, military ID card, passport, or other current and valid photo ID. If you don't have ID, you will be required to vote a questioned ballot.

The division is hoping for a good turnout and that means there may be a line at the polls. Please be patient. The election workers will process you and give you a ballot as quickly as possible.
