### Absentee Voting for the August 24<sup>th</sup> Primary Election Has Begun!

The Division of Elections announces that absentee in-person voting is available August 9<sup>th</sup> through the August 24<sup>th</sup> Primary Election.

Each of the Division offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau, Nome and Wasilla have ballots for all districts. Voters who are registered anywhere in the state may go to one of the Division's offices and receive a ballot for their area. The offices are open Monday – Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. In addition, the offices will be open Saturday, August 21<sup>st</sup> from 10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and again on Sunday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> from 12:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. The locations of the Division offices are:

Anchorage – 2525 Gambell Street  
Fairbanks – 675 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue  
Juneau – Mendenhall Mall  
Nome – State Office Building, Front Street  
Wasilla – 1700 E. Bogard Road

In addition to the Division offices, absentee in-person voting is available through designated voting officials across the state. Voters may obtain a listing of the absentee in-person voting locations on the Division's web site at [www.elections.alaska.gov](http://www.elections.alaska.gov) or by calling any of the Division offices.

For those voters who would like to receive a ballot in the mail, the application deadline is Saturday, August 14<sup>th</sup>. Applications are available on the Division's web site or through any of the Division offices.
