

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF EMERGENCY REGULATIONS
OF THE DIVISION OF ELECTIONS
OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The Division of Elections proposes to change regulations on the replacement for a withdrawn lieutenant governor candidate nominated by petition. There is no procedure in place at this time for a non-party candidate for governor to fill the vacancy created by the withdrawal.

On September 2, 2014, the Division of Elections adopted, as emergency regulations, changes in Title 6 of the Alaska Administrative Code dealing with replacement for a candidate nominated by petition, including the following:

- (1) 6 AAC 25.225 which sets out a new procedure for replacement for a withdrawn lieutenant governor candidate nominated by petition.

The emergency regulations took effect September 2, 2014 and will expire December 30, 2014. The Division of Elections intends to make the emergency regulations permanent.
