Absentee Voting for the August 26th Primary Election Has Begun!

The Division of Elections announces that absentee in-person voting is available now through the August 26th Primary Election.

Each of the Division offices in Anchorage, Fairbanks, Juneau, Nome and Wasilla have ballots for all districts. Voters who are registered anywhere in the state may go to one of the Division's offices and receive a ballot for their area. The offices are open Monday – Friday from 8:00am until 5:00pm. In addition, the offices will be open Saturday August 23rd from 10:00am – 4:00pm and again on Sunday, August 24th from 12:00pm – 4:00pm. The locations of the Division offices are:

Anchorage – 2525 Gambell Street
Fairbanks – 675 7th Avenue
Juneau – Mendenhall Mall
Nome – State Office Building, Front Street
Wasilla – 1700 E. Bogard Road

In addition to the Division offices, absentee in-person voting is available through designated voting officials across the state. Voters may obtain a listing of the absentee in-person voting locations on the Division's web site at www.elections.alaska.gov or by calling any of the Division offices.

For those voters who would like to receive a ballot in the mail, the application deadline is Saturday, August 16th. Applications are available on the Division's web site or through any of the Division offices.
