April 3, 2007 Election Day

The State of Alaska Statewide Special Election will be held in conjunction with the Municipality of Anchorage's regularly scheduled local election on Tuesday, April 3, 2007. Precinct and absentee in person voting will be available in the same locations for those areas within the Municipality of Anchorage and will offer both the State of Alaska and the Municipality of Anchorage ballots. There will be separate ballots for the State of Alaska and the Municipality of Anchorage.

Absentee in person voting will be available for both elections beginning on Monday, March 19, 2007. To find an absentee voting location near you, and to determine which ballots will be available at that location, please call your local elections office or visit the State of Alaska, Division of Elections' website at: www.elections.state.ak.us.

Absentee by mail voting, absentee by FAX voting and special needs voting, for those voters who are unable to go to the polls on election day due to age, serious illness or disability, is also available and voters must apply separately to the State of Alaska Division of Elections and the Municipality of Anchorage.
