Position Statement:

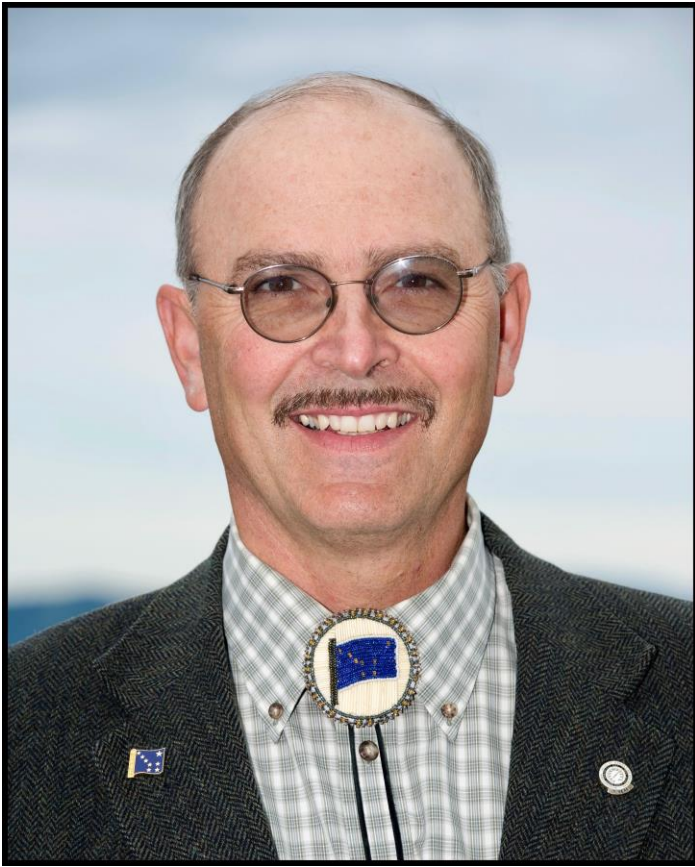
