Position Statement:

- I voted NO on SB 91 (the “omnibus” crime bill). SB 91 was strongly opposed by law enforcement and victim’s rights groups. In addition, I was the author of amendment 11 to SB 54 which would have completely repealed SB 91.
- As the current representative for House District 12, I have helped reduce state spending and proposed dozens of other specific reductions to state spending.
- I have voted against every effort to reduce that statutory dividend calculation and I support allowing Alaskans the right to vote on any change to the formula.
- I authored a new constitutional spending limit that, if adopted, would prohibit ANY spending increases during a deficit.
- During the 30th Legislature I co-sponsored legislation that would move the legislative session out of Juneau.
- As a conceal-carry permit holder, I strongly support Alaska’s “castle” and “stand your ground” doctrines.
