### About The View Petition Totals Report

The first phase of signature review is computer qualification. The information provided by the signers in each booklet such as name, address, identifier and date of signature are entered into the statewide voter registration system. Daily, a computer qualification program is run comparing the information entered from each booklet against the official voter registration records in the statewide voter registration system. When the system locates an exact match, it will automatically qualify signers and this number will be reported in the (Q) *Computer Qualified*: column. When the system cannot match the information data entered, this number will be reported in the *Number of Unqualified* column. The reason why signers are not qualified is reported on the right-hand side of the report.

The second phase of signature review is manual qualification. The division will research each signer that was not qualified during the computer qualification phase (those that appear in the *Number of Unqualified*: column). This involves a manual search of the statewide voter registration system for each signer to determine if they are a qualified registered voter. If a successful match is found, the signer will be manually qualified and appear in the (M) *Manually Qualified* column. If the signer is not a qualified voter or their signature information was incomplete, they will remain in the *Number of Unqualified*: column. The column located on the right-hand side of the report reflects the reason for disqualification.

If a signer's voter registration record was inactivated before the receipt of the petition booklets, such as a voter who may have signed a booklet and then passed away after signing, will appear in the (H) *Inactive Qualified* column. Since the signer was a qualified registered voter at the time of signing the petition, they would qualify as an eligible signature.
