# Alaska Electronic Transmission Absentee Ballot Application For Federal and State General Elections

## Apply for a federal and state electronic transmission ballot

- To request an electronic transmission ballot, you must be a qualified registered voter 30 days before Election Day except in a U.S. presidential election.
- See the information below on how to register to vote and participate in the presidential election race.
- Use this form to apply for an electronic transmission absentee ballot for the November 3, 2020 General Election.

## Alaska residence address

- Provide an Alaska residence address. Your application will be denied if you provide an out-of-state address, PO Box, HC number and box, rural route, commercial address, mail stop address, etc.

## Temporarily out-of-state and intent to return?

- You may maintain your Alaska residence address as the address you lived at prior to leaving Alaska or where you are currently registered in Alaska. *Active military members and spouses, you are exempt from the intent to return to Alaska requirement.*

## Permanent mailing address

- Provide a permanent mailing address.

## U.S. presidential election voter registration information

- In a presidential election, Alaska law allows for same day voter registration and vote in the presidential election race.
- To register to vote, and request an electronic transmission ballot, you must complete a voter registration application and submit it along with your completed electronic transmission application.
- You may locate the voter registration application on our web page <http://www.elections.alaska.gov/Core/voterregistration.php>. Select the paper registration option.
- Your completed voter registration application and electronic transmission application MUST be received by 5:00 p.m. Alaska Standard Time on Monday, November 2, 2020.

## Identifiers and contact

- You MUST provide ONE identifier.
- Provide a contact telephone number. If there is a problem with your application, we will contact you.

## Indicate how you want your ballot sent

### Online Delivery:

- You must provide an email address.
- You will receive email notification of ballot availability to your email address and instructions on how to log into the online web portal.
- Depending on your spam/junk email filters, check your spam/junk mail folders for your notification.
- You will need to have access to a computer and printer to print your voted ballot and voter certificate.
- You may only return your voted ballot back by-mail or by-fax.

### Fax Delivery:

- You must provide a fax number.
- Be sure to provide area code with your fax number and, when having your ballot sent internationally, your international number, country code and fax number.
- You may only return your voted ballot back by-mail or by-fax.

- Please select the option that best describes you.

## Deadlines

- You may use this application to apply for an electronic transmission ballot beginning on October 19, 2020.
- If you submit this application before this day, your request will be denied and you will need to reapply.
- Your completed application must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. Alaska Standard Time on Monday, November 2, 2020.
