<b>Wednesday, August 10, 2016</b>	A Limited Political Party petition for presidential candidates must be submitted to the Division of Elections by this date. The petition must have at least 3,017 signatures of registered Alaska voters. AS 15.30.025(a)
<b>Wednesday, August 10, 2016</b>	An Independent Candidate petition for presidential candidates must be submitted to the Division of Elections by this date. The petition must have at least 3,017 signatures of registered Alaska voters. AS 15.30.026
<b>Tuesday, August 30, 2016</b>	Candidates for President and Vice President must have photographs, statements advocating their candidacy and the appropriate fee in the Division of Elections office by this date to be printed in the <i>Official Election Pamphlet</i> . AS 15.58.030(a)
<b>Thursday, September 1, 2016</b>	Last day for political parties and qualified independent candidates to submit names of electors to the Division of Elections. AS 15.30.020 & AS 15.30.026(b)
<b>Tuesday, September 6, 2016</b>	Last day for a candidate to withdraw their name from the General Election ballot. AS 15.25.200, 6AAC 25.210(b)
<b>Tuesday, September 6, 2016</b>	Last day for parties to submit a certificate with the names of their candidates for President and Vice President to appear on the November 8, 2016 General Election ballot.
<b>Wednesday, September 7, 2016</b>	Ballot layout certified for printing.
<b>Thursday, November 3, 2016</b>	Last day to file a <i>Letter of Intent</i> as a write-in candidate for the 2016 General Election. AS 15.25.105(c)
<b>Tuesday, November 8, 2016</b>	General Election Day. AS 15.15.020
<b>Monday, December 19, 2016</b>	Electors meet at 11:00 a.m. to cast their votes for President and Vice President. AS 15.30.070
