NO-PARTY CANDIDATE FILING REQUIREMENTS

A candidate, who is not representing a recognized political party, files a Filing Notification form by the filing deadline, **MONDAY, JUNE 1, 2020**. Candidates filing in this manner are also required to collect signatures of registered voters who support their candidacy. The number of signatures required is set out in AS 15.25.160, AS 15.25.170, and varies for each office. The H06 handout is available on the Division of Elections website at <http://www.elections.alaska.gov/doc/forms/H06.pdf> to determine the required number of signatures for no-party nominating petitions.

In addition to the Filing Notification, the candidate must also file the Nominating Petition form with the required signatures by 5:00 p.m. on the date of the Primary Election, **TUESDAY, AUGUST 18, 2020**. Alaska's Primary Election is a partially closed primary. Candidates who file for office that do not represent a recognized political party will appear only on the General Election ballot. No filing fee is required.

Below is a checklist provided as a convenience to the candidate filing for office. Candidates are free to declare their candidacy in another format provided it complies with the provisions of AS 15.25.150 through AS 15.25.180.

CHECKLIST FOR FILING FOR OFFICE

- Complete the Filing Notification form (A19).** Identify the name of the political group you are affiliated with, if applicable. The name of your political group will follow the candidate's name on the ballot. If you have not provided a political group's name, the space on the ballot that indicates party or political group affiliation will be listed as "Non Affiliated." AS 15.15.030(5), AS 15.25.140, AS 15.25.150
- Sign your Declaration of Candidacy before a Notary.** A Notary is available at all Division of Elections offices. AS 15.25.030(a)
- Contact the Federal Election Commission for federal reporting deadlines.** Candidates for U.S. Senator or U.S. Representative must contact the Federal Election Commission for campaign reporting requirements. These candidates are not subject to the Alaska Public Offices Commission requirements. AS 15.25.030(b), AS 15.25.030(c), AS 39.50
- File completed forms no later than 5:00 p.m. on the filing deadline, MONDAY, JUNE 1, 2020.** The Filing Notification must be filed with the Director of Elections or any Division of Elections Office. All Division of Elections Offices will be open 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. AS 15.25.040
- Collect signatures.** Gather the appropriate number of signatures needed for the particular office for which the candidate is filing. See the H06 handout for the number of signatures required for no-party nominating petitions. The Subscribers' Page can be duplicated as needed for use in collecting signatures. AS 15.25.160-170
- Complete the Nominating Petition.** The candidate completes and files the Nominating Petition form (A19A). The Nominating Petition form is filed simultaneously with the signature pages (A19B) supporting this candidate. The forms are provided in this packet and/or on the Division of Elections website. AS 15.25.180

- Mon., 06/01/20 **Filing deadline for both party and no-party candidates.** Party candidates must file a "Declaration of Candidacy" and appropriate Financial Disclosure Statement for any office appearing on the Primary Election ballot. No-party candidates must file a "Filing Notification" and Financial Disclosure Statement by this date. Election offices will be open 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. AS 15.25.040, AS 15.25.150
- Thur., 06/11/20 Last day to file a complaint with the Division of Elections regarding the eligibility of a candidate. AS 15.25.042 and 6 AAC 25.260
- Tues., 06/16/20 Candidates who faxed filing materials to the Division of Elections by the June 1st deadline must have their mailed documents received by the Division of Elections by this date. AS 15.25.040(a)(2)
- Mon., 06/29/20 Last day for candidates to withdraw their names from Primary Election ballot. *(Since the 52nd day prior to the General Election falls on a Saturday, the deadline is moved to the next business day.)* AS 15.25.055
- Wed., 07/22/20 **Candidate deadline for Official Election Pamphlet information material.** Candidates submit materials to the Division of Elections for the state's 2020 General Election voter pamphlet.
- Mon., 08/03/20 **Filing deadline for judges seeking retention.** Candidates for judicial retention must file a Declaration of Candidacy for Retention and Financial Disclosure Statement. *(Since the 1st of August falls on a Saturday, the deadline is moved to the next business day.)* AS 15.35.040, AS 15.35.055, AS 15.35.070, AS 15.35.110, AS 39.50.020
- Fri., 08/07/20 **Judicial retention deadline for Official Election Pamphlet information material.** Judges and the Judicial Council submit materials to the Division of Elections for the state's 2020 General Election voter pamphlet. AS 15.58.030(g), AS 15.58.050
- Tues., 08/18/20 **PRIMARY ELECTION DAY.** AS 15.25.020
- Tues., 08/18/20 **Filing deadline for no-party candidates to submit petition signatures.** No-party candidates must submit petition signatures by this date by 5:00 p.m. Alaska time. AS 15.25.150
- Mon., 08/31/20 Last day for candidates to withdraw their names from the General Election ballot. AS 15.25.200, AS 15.35.135
- Mon., 08/31/20 Deadline for filling vacancies by party petition. AS 15.25.110

****IMPORTANT NOTICE****
Official Election Pamphlet Information

Prior to the General Election, the Division of Elections distributes the Official Election Pamphlet (OEP) to the households of registered voters. The pamphlet contains information about candidates and issues appearing on the General Election ballot. In addition, the information submitted by candidates for the OEP is posted to the division's website prior to the election in which the candidate will appear on the ballot.

****Please note:** For the Primary Elections, a ballot measure only pamphlet is mailed to voters only if a ballot measure appears on the Primary Election ballot. Candidate information **does not** appear in a Primary Election pamphlet.

All candidates who wish to appear in the pamphlet must submit the materials listed below by the statutory deadline. **Late submissions will not be accepted.** The division recommends filing your materials as soon as possible. Materials should be submitted electronically. Forms for making the submission are available on the division's website at: <http://elections.alaska.gov/Core/oepinfocandidates.php>

1. **Candidate Statement:** A biographical statement of 150 words or less and a position statement of 250 words or less. AS 15.58.030(e)
2. **Photograph:** A 5" x 7" photograph (five inches wide by seven inches high) taken within the last five years and limited to the head, neck and shoulders of the candidate. All photographs will be printed in black and white. AS 15.58.030(f)
3. **Filing Fee:** Submit payment in the appropriate amount to the State of Alaska, Division of Elections. (cash, check, credit card accepted) AS 15.58.060(a)
 - a. \$300.00 – President of the United States, Vice President of the United States, United States Senator, United States Representative, Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Supreme Court Justice, Court of Appeals Judge
 - b. \$150.00 – Superior Court Judge, District Court Judge
 - c. \$100.00 – State Senator, State Representative

Statutory Deadlines:

- State/Federal Candidates: **Wednesday, July 22, 2020** (AS 15.58.030(b))
- Judicial Retention Candidates: **Friday, August 7, 2020** (AS 15.58.030(g))

NOTE: Materials for Alaska Native language translation must be received 30 days before the statutory deadlines. If submitted by this deadline, materials will be translated for a candidate for a federal or statewide office, a candidate for State Senate in Districts C, S, or T, a candidate for State Representative in House Districts 06, 37 – 40, or a judicial retention candidate for Supreme Court, Court of Appeals or judicial districts 2, 3 or 4. We **strongly encourage** you to submit your pamphlet material following this requirement so that the division can have your information translated to assist limited English proficient Alaska Native voters. We cannot accept already translated submissions.

Translation deadlines: State/Federal Candidates: **Monday, June 20 2020**; Judicial Retention Candidates: **Wednesday, July 8, 2020**

POLITICAL GROUPS IN ALASKA

A “political group” is an organized group of voters representing a political program that would like to gain status as a recognized political party. In order to obtain recognized status, a political group must file an application with the Director of the Division of Elections requesting that the number of registered voters for their group be tracked. An application may be obtained from the division’s website at: <http://elections.alaska.gov/doc/forms/A02.pdf>. The Director will recognize the group as a political party in accordance with the requirements of AS 15.80.008 and AS 15.80.010(26).

Until the political group qualifies as a recognized political party under AS 15.80.010(26), the political group may only field candidates for statewide and districtwide offices for the general election by filing nominating petitions as required by AS 15.25.140 - 15.25.200. Nominating petition candidates do not participate in primary elections.

The Division produces a monthly report entitled *Number of Registered Voters by Party within Precinct*. The report lists the number of registered voters within each recognized political party and political group that has applied to obtain recognized status. The report is available from any Division of Elections office or on the division’s website at: <http://elections.alaska.gov/Core/voterregistrationstatistics.php>

Candidates representing a political group file a Filing Notification form, gather signatures from a specified number of qualified registered voters, and file a Financial Disclosure Statement.

There are two filing dates for nominating petition candidates:

- Candidates must file their Filing Notification form on or before 5:00 p.m. **Monday, June 1, 2020** at any Division of Elections Office for the **November 3, 2020** General Election. When filing for office, candidates must have their Financial Disclosure Statement already on file with the Alaska Public Offices Commission or must submit it simultaneously with the Filing Notification form.
- The Nominating Petition form and signatures of qualified registered voters required for the office the candidate filed for, must be received by actual physical delivery in person to a Division of Elections office on or before 5:00 p.m. on the day of the Primary Election **August 18, 2020**, or by actual physical delivery to the Division of Elections by registered or certified mail return receipt requested postmarked at or before 5:00 p.m., prevailing time, on the day of the Primary Election **August 18, 2020** to any Division of Elections Office and received not more than 15 days after that time.

METHODS FOR FILING YOUR NO PARTY OR NOMINATING PETITION CANDIDATE PAPERWORK

Candidates may submit the information required under AS 15.25.180(a)(1) – (8) and (11) – (17) with the Division of Elections no later than 5:00 p.m. on **MONDAY, JUNE 1, 2020** using one of the methods listed below:

- In person - Filing Notification may be delivered in person to any Division of Elections Office no later than 5:00 p.m. on the filing deadline.
- By mail - A Filing Notification sent by mail must be received by the Division of Elections no later than 5:00 p.m. on the filing deadline. If the postmark is illegible, a dated receipt from the post office where dispatched shall be acceptable evidence of mailing. Filing Notifications may be mailed to any Division of Elections Office.
- By reliable electronic transmission - A Filing Notification or a copy of the statements made under AS 15.25.180(a) (1) – (8) and (11) – (17) may be electronically transmitted to any Division of Elections Office and must be received by the division no later than 5:00 p.m. on the filing deadline. The original filing notification containing paragraphs (1) - (8) and (11) - (17), as required by AS 15.25.180(a), must be received by the Division of Elections within 15 days of the filing deadline.
