### Position Statement

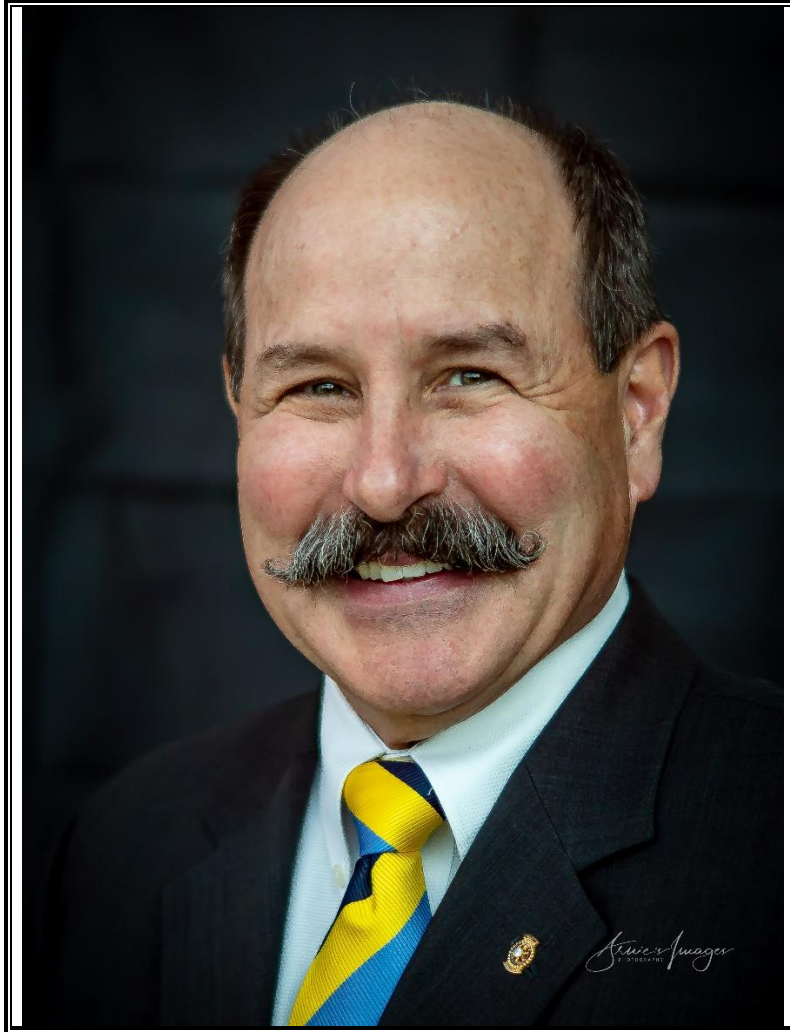
I respectfully ask for your vote to elect me as your Representative for House District 23.
