Position Statement

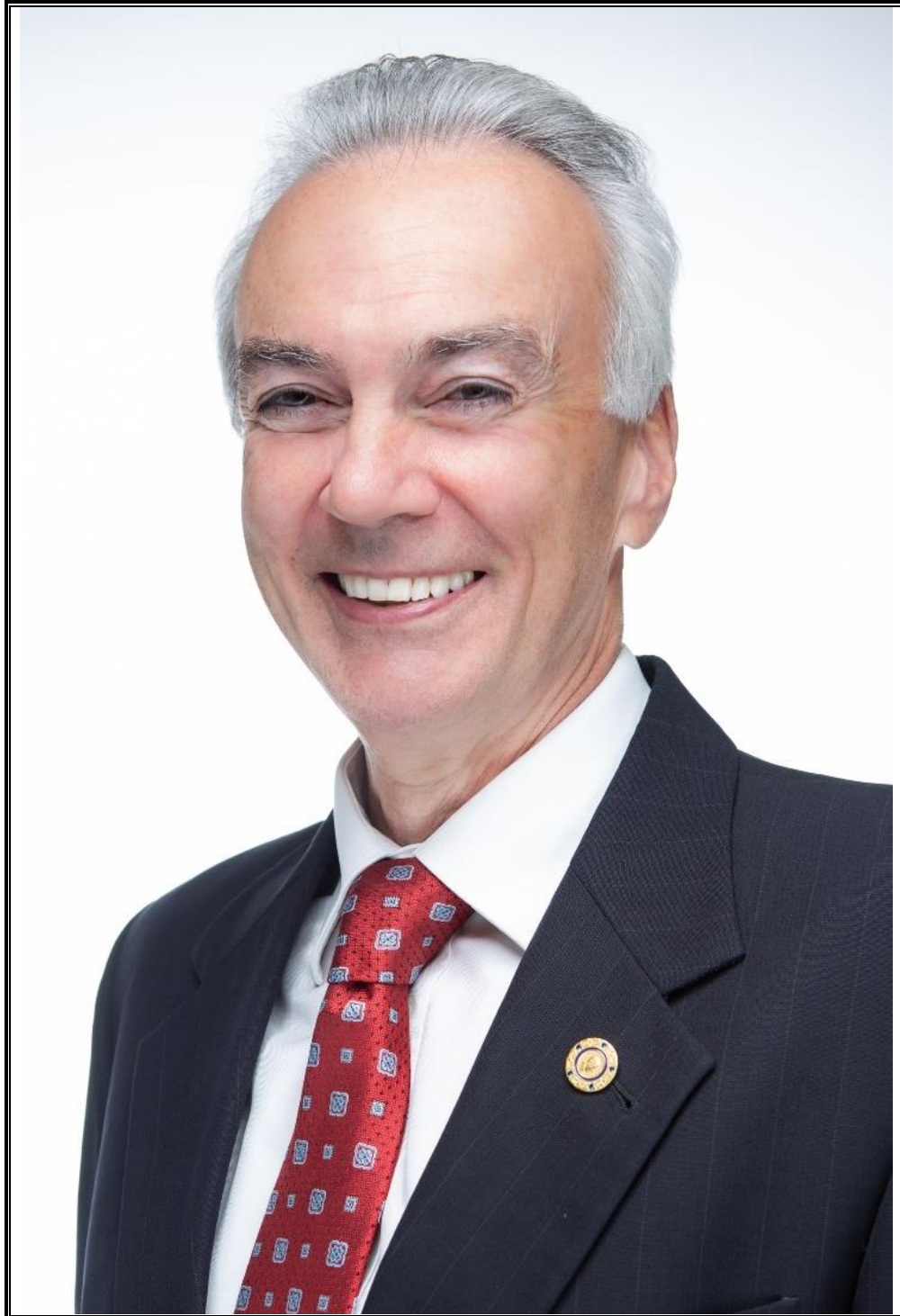
