### **Position Statement**

I'm running for House District 6 because I care deeply for the Kenai Peninsula. I've lived in Homer for 30 years; there is not an area of our district of which I do not have a fond memory. Alaska is at a major crossroads. We are being asked by our government to make a false choice: have a large PFD or fund critical services like education and public safety. We don't have to adopt that false choice if Alaska adopts a long-term fiscal plan.

If elected, I have four key priorities:

1. Solve the fiscal crisis. Tax out-of-state workers and lower the per-barrel oil credit that loses the state \$1 billion a year.
2. Protect and grow the Permanent Fund and Dividend. Put the Dividend in the Constitution and stop a future legislature from spending down the earnings.
3. Fight for our fisheries. Science, not politics, should dictate fisheries management in Alaska. Legislators must compel the state to agree to a co-management plan in the EEZ to stop top-down control from the feds.
4. Support all public education. Public and homeschool families deserve certainty over the funding their child receives. Let's patch up holes in correspondence legislation and pin the BSA to inflation.
