I was born and raised in Ketchikan. I am running for state house because I understand the issues facing communities in District 1: lack of affordable housing, a fishing industry in crisis, continual cuts to our PFD and years of stagnant education funding.

As Executive director of WISH, a member of the Alaska mental health Trust Board, and a director on the FirstBank Board, I have worked to address these issues.

At WISH I brought over \$20 million of grant funding into District 1 communities. I secured funding to place counselors and social workers into local schools. I developed a housing program that placed over 100 families into stable housing. As a director for FirstBank, I see firsthand the hardships fishermen are facing; higher costs, lower fish prices and fewer processors to sell to.

I am running for state house because I understand the issues our communities are facing and I have an established track record of addressing them.
