A court ruling in 2021 removed the limits on contributions by individuals. With this act, individuals could give \$2,000 to candidates and \$5,000 to political parties. Groups besides political parties could give \$4,000 to candidates and \$5,000 to other parties or groups. Individuals could also give \$4,000 to joint campaigns for governor and lieutenant governor, and groups could give \$8,000.
