★ **TO VOTE:**

A ballot will be mailed to you on November 1, 2010. The ballots will be mailed to the mailing address on your voter record. If your mailing address has changed, if your mail will be forwarded during this time, or if you will not be at your mailing address, contact the Region III Elections Office at the number listed below. Ballots **WILL NOT BE FORWARDED** by the Post Office.

You have from the time you receive your ballot until Election Day to vote your ballot.

For your ballot to be counted, you must:

1. Sign the return ballot envelope.
2. Provide at least one identifier on the return ballot envelope.
3. Have your signature witnessed. Ask an authorized official, such as the postmaster, city clerk or election official **or** one person over the age of 18 to be your witness.
4. Ballots must be voted and postmarked on or before **Tuesday, November 23, 2010**.

An Absentee Voting official will have ballots and will be available for absentee in-person voting and assistance in Aniak, November 8 through November 23, at the Kuspuk School District Offices Monday through Friday from 8:30am – 4:30pm, closed Noon to 1:00pm.

In addition, ballots and other assistance will also be available at the Fairbanks, Anchorage, Wasilla, Juneau and Nome election offices. If you do not receive your ballot in the mail, you may obtain a ballot through one of these offices.
