

**ORDER AND NOTICE OF ELECTION
REAA #20 RUNOFF ELECTION**

Pursuant to the provisions of AS 14.08.071(b) and 6 AAC 27.090, a runoff election for the Annette Island School District (REAA #20) School Board, Seat A will be held on November 22, 2011.

The election will be conducted by mail in accordance with AS 15.20.800, 6 AAC 25.590 and 6 AAC 27.010 - 27.110 and in the general manner prescribed by Alaska's Election Code. There will be no polling place open for regular in-person voting on Election Day.

The election will be held to fill the following designated seat for the term of office specified.

Voting: This is a by-mail election and there will be no polling places open for regular in-person voting on Election Day. Ballots will automatically be mailed to voters on Monday, October 31, 2011.

Absentee In Person Voting: An absentee voting official will be available in Metlakatla beginning Monday, November 7, 2011 through November 22, 2011.
