Shall the City of Big Lake be authorized to levy a 3.09 mill property tax? (This property tax will, in effect, take the place of certain property taxes currently levied by the borough in the area proposed for incorporation for (1) the Big Lake Roads RSA #21 tax, and (2) the non-areawide property tax for economic development, libraries and animal care. Approval of this proposition is a condition for incorporation. Voters must authorize the City of Big Lake to levy a 3.09 mill property tax in order for incorporation to occur.)
